Applications Being Accepted: Memorial Scholarship Honors Wildlife Officer Larry A. Hart

EATON, Ohio—The Larry A. Hart Memorial Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce they are accepting applications for the Larry A. Hart Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship is funded by the Ohio Wildlife Officers' (Lodge 143) of the Fraternal Order of Police and Twin Valley Rod and Gun Club of Preble County. This year, two additional organizations, Safari Club International and the National Deer Association – Twin Creek Branch, have joined us to Honor Larry A. Hart.

Larry A. Hart was a thirty-year veteran of the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Wildlife. For most of his career, Larry served as a wildlife officer assigned to Preble County. Later, he worked as a Wildlife Officer/Field Supervisor in southwest Ohio. The legacy of integrity and commitment to Wildlife Management and Law Enforcement set by Officer Hart is still remembered by those in the communities he served, and serves as the gold standard today's young officers strive to attain.

To receive the two-thousand-dollar scholarship, the applicant must be a resident of Ohio, who have, or will graduate from an accredited high school; or, any person who is, or will be enrolled in an accredited college, pursuing a career in the field(s) of law enforcement, fish and wildlife management and/or similar natural resources studies.

- 1. TYPE OF SCHOLARSHIP: This is a one-year scholarship in the amount of twothousand-dollars. Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the Bursar of the college where the recipient is or will be attending.
- 2. WHO MAY APPLY?
 - A. Any person who is an Ohio resident;
 - B. Any person who has or will be graduated from an accredited high school;
 - C. Any person who is or will be enrolled in an accredited college and will be pursuing a career in the field of law enforcement, fish & wildlife or similar natural resources studies.
- 3. WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?
 - A. GOAL The applicant shall have a desire to pursue a career in the field(s) of law enforcement and/or protection or management of natural resources.
 - B. INTEREST The applicant must have a serious interest in advancing his or her education in natural resources and/or law enforcement studies.
 - C. SELECTION OF INSTITUTION The recipient of this scholarship must choose to attend an accredited institution, be it college, university, or technical college.
- D. ATTITUDES AND ACTIVITIES The applicant shall demonstrate the upstanding character and positive personal attributes necessary for becoming a successful public servant through his or her participation in extracurricular activities, such as church and/or other community service. If the applicant fails to maintain these standards, the committee reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship at any time.
